ADK foundation: Rich Kroes

- Presentation on ADK Foundation and its relationship with the SOA.
- Three funds, SOA has all three with Vanguard.
- Five pillars of ADK foundation, 90 million in assets, 70 million grants given out.
- Explanation of the list of funds held with the Foundation and their purpose.

ADK Land Trust: Mike Carr

- Founded in 1984, 22 Board members, 25 current projects, and 1.5 million in assets.
- Many current SOA members are on the Board, including Meredith Prime, Cathy McGraw, and Kip Testwuide.
- Merged with old Land Conservancy.

Town Supervisor: Derek Doty

- Introduction of Mike Orticelle as the code enforcement officer for the Town.
- Review of Septic regulations, Q&As.
- Land use code has been updated.

LAKE MANAGEMENT PLAN - Scott Donnelly

- Management Plan is finished. Handout provided.
- Goals:
 - Help with Grant Activity
 - Lake Management
 - Water Quality
 - Invasives
 - Recreational Use
 - Land Development

INVASIVE SPECIES: David Bumsted

- Two primary efforts:
- Working with ADK Watershed Institute and Paul Smiths.
- DEC provides coverage 5 days a week, SOA funds remaining days for 7 days/week.
- Facing labor shortage with workers.
- Slide presentation given for Boat Inspection Data. Failed inspections are up, invasives are down, 80 boats with invasives observed and stopped.
- New NY law mandating all boats be inspected for invasives before entering lakes. Can self-certify if your boat doesn't leave the Lake.
- Download is on DEC website.
- In 2019 1,700lbs of invasives were removed, in 2022 under 19lbs.

BOAT SAFETY: Hilary McDonald

- 1st strait still has a wake issue.
- Less boat traffic this year.
- Big wake board boats are an issue now at state level.
- Buzzy the constable is out everyday.
- Buzzy Rickard, Lake Constable:
 - 1/3 traffic this year compared to last.
 - Stopping people and educating them on the rules of lake.
 - Review of boating laws.
 - He is not fining people, but the DEC will.
 - Certification for driving boat rules.
 - Rental companies are doing a good job educating their customers, it is the locals that cause most problems.
 - *Scott:* Re-evaluated what is going on in the strait and the local town has the authority to change the laws.

PROPERTY UPDATE: Georgia Jones

- Damn and False outlet properties, purchased 1894, 4 acres, mostly wooded.
- Buildings that were on the property that belong to Fish property have been removed.
- False Outlet, 1 acre, items that were being stored there by neighbor have been removed as well.

ADMINISTRATION: Cristina Lussi

Thousands of pages have been scanned, minutes will all be online sometime in the future.

DAM: Bill Kaufman

- Putting together a long-term plan.
- Dam has a few issues. Water is coming in under the dam.
- Clear vegetation around the dam, safety devices for railing are in.
- Will need a fundraising effort in the future for a long-term plan. The dam was remodeled in 1995. The core is good, abutments need work.
